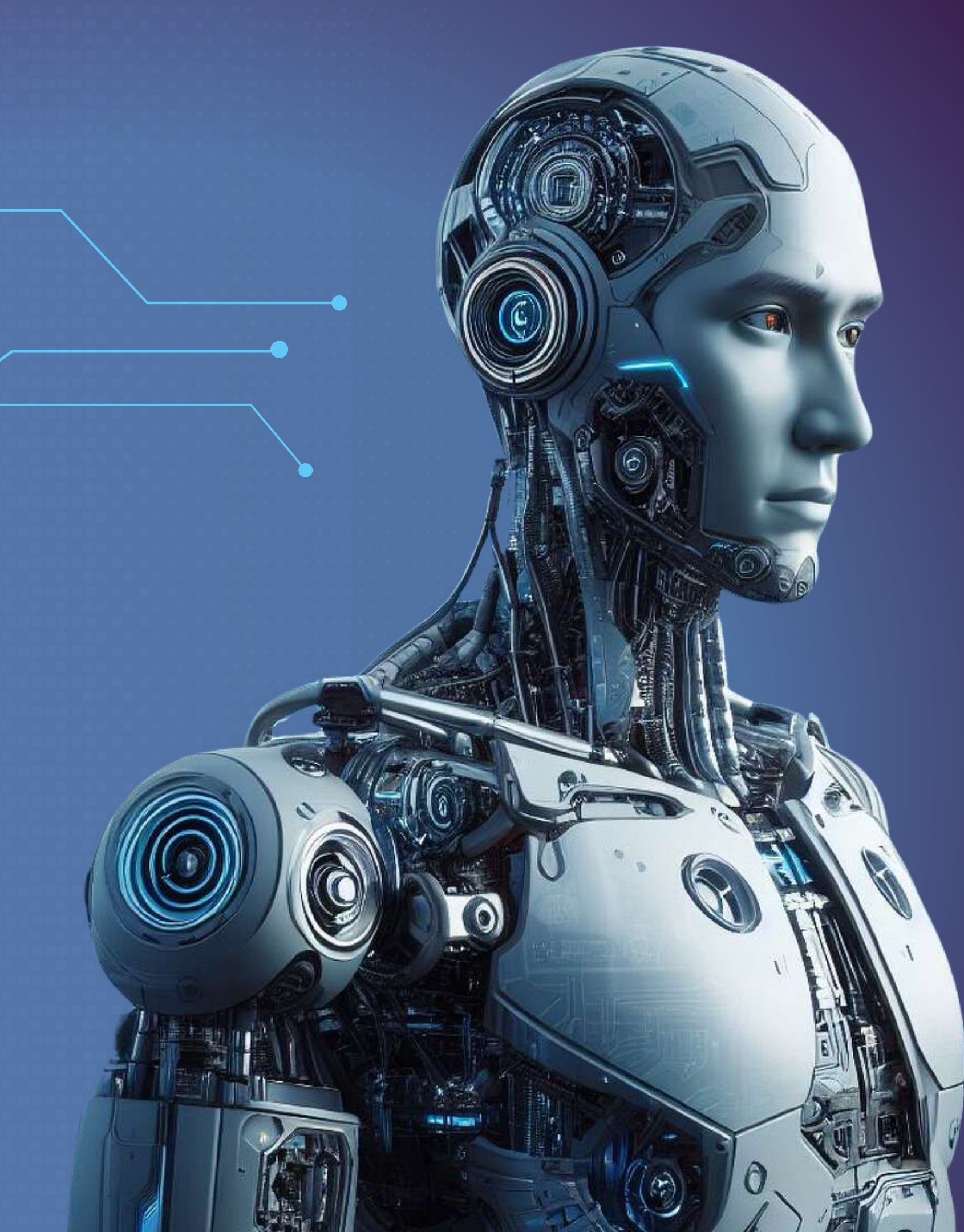
WHAT IS A PROMPT?

A prompt is an instruction or question given to AI that shapes what it creates and how it responds.

We use this everyday in our lives. Example: Go make a sandwich, Enjoy this class, etc.

A prompt is the input that guides AI systems to generate specific outputs. The way you phrase your request directly determines what you'll receive—from direct commands to open-ended questions, your words are the blueprint for AI creation.

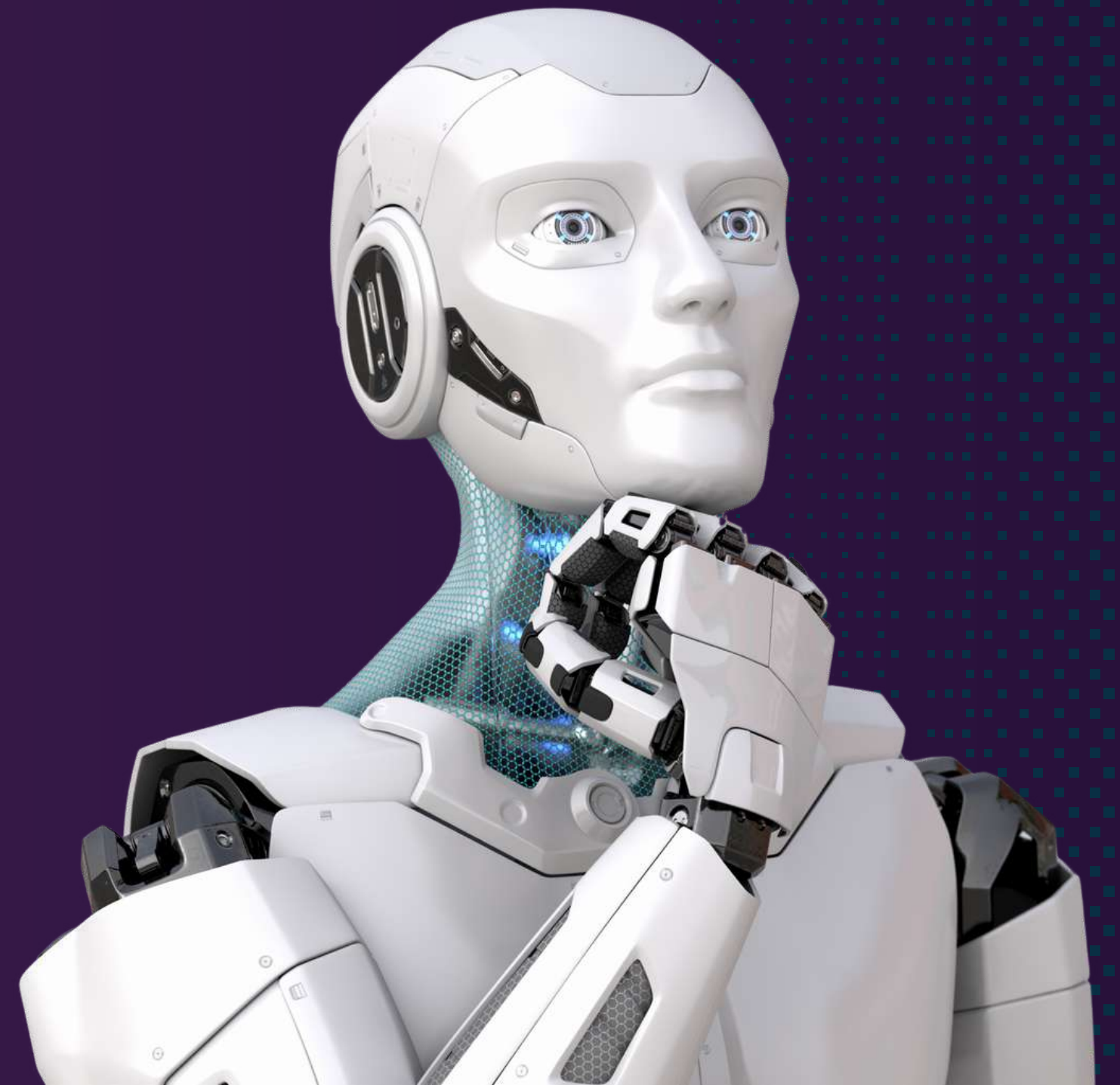
Human prompts are rooted in cultural content. Prompts for AI are built to be rooted in relevant context.



WHAT IS PROMPT ENGINEERING?

Prompt engineering in that sense is a process of crafting optimised prompts to drive relevant output from large language models. Some of these models include o1, GPT-4o, Claude 4 Sonnet and even image generation models like DALL·E, Stable Diffusion.

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TECHNIQUES OF PROMPT ENGINEERING

ZERO-SHOT PROMPTING

- **Definition:** Involves giving the model direct instructions or questions without providing any examples or context.
- **Use Case:** Best for simple tasks like factual queries or straightforward instructions.
- **Example:** "What are the causes of global warming?"
- **Advantages:** Quick and simple; works well for tasks the model is already trained on.

ONE-SHOT PROMPTING

- **Definition:** Provides a single example to illustrate the desired response format or style.
- **Use Case:** Useful for guiding the model efficiently when zero-shot learning fails.
- **Example:** "Given example: Burning fossil fuels releases carbon dioxide, leading to global warming. Now, explain how industrial agriculture contributes to climate change."
- **Advantages:** Improves accuracy for moderately complex tasks.

FEW-SHOT PROMPTING

- **Definition:** Supplies multiple examples to enhance the model's understanding of the task and expected output.
- **Use Case:** Ideal for complex queries requiring nuanced responses.
- **Example:** "Given examples: Deforestation reduces carbon absorption, industrial agriculture emits methane. Now, describe how urbanization affects climate change."
- **Advantages:** Enhances reliability and consistency in complex tasks.

TECHNIQUES OF PROMPT ENGINEERING

CHAIN-OF-THOUGHT PROMPTING

- **Definition:** Breaks down complex reasoning into intermediate steps to improve accuracy.
- **Use Case:** Helps solve problems requiring logical reasoning or multi-step calculations.
- **Example:** "Solve $2x + 3 = 11$ by first subtracting 3 from both sides, then dividing by 2."
- **Advantages:** Enhances reasoning capabilities and reduces errors in complex tasks.

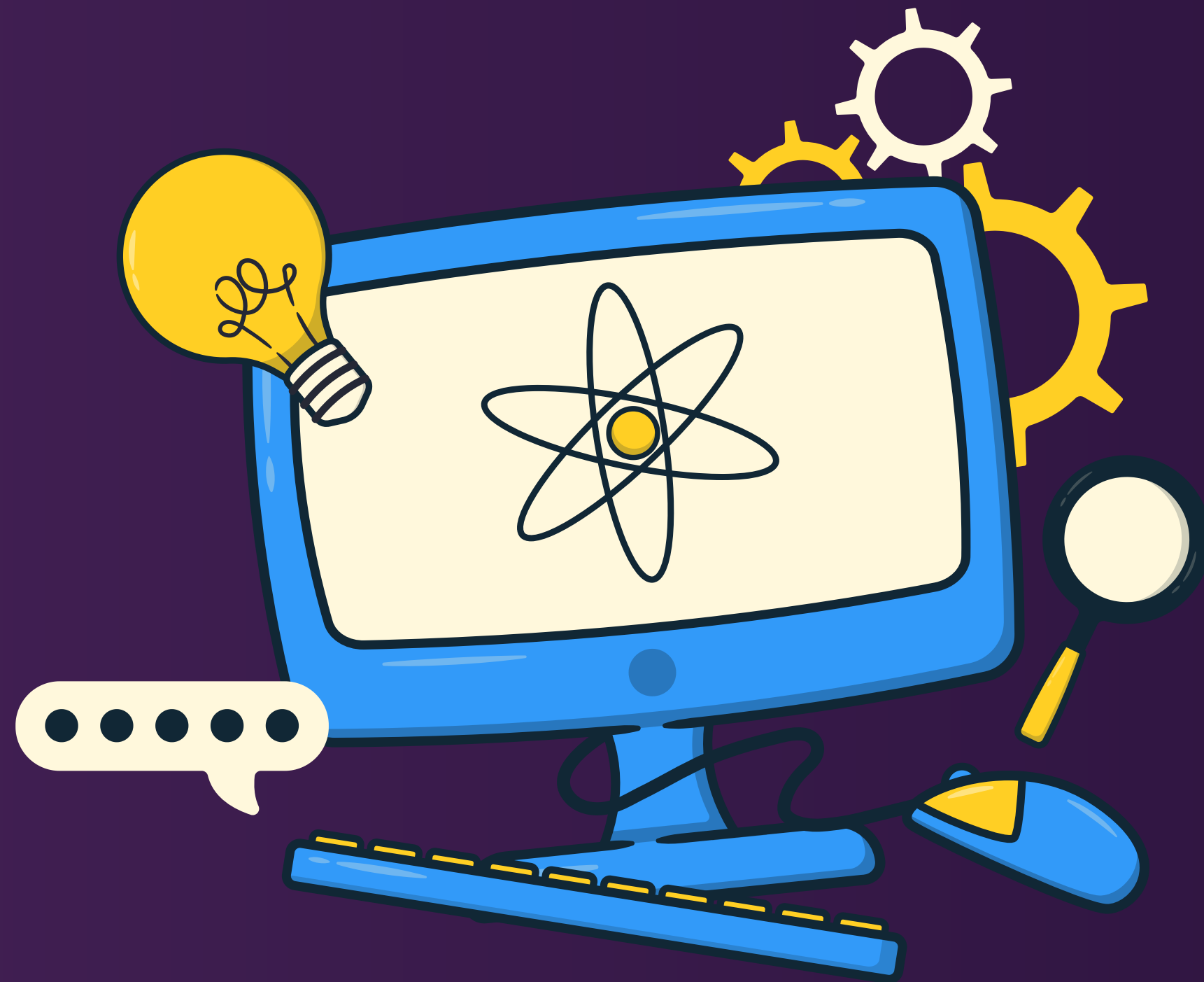
NEGATIVE PROMPTING

- **Definition:** Specifies what the AI should avoid generating in its response.
- **Use Case:** Useful for filtering undesired outputs (e.g., avoiding specific styles or topics).
- **Example:** "Write a poem about love but avoid mentioning heartbreak."
- **Advantages:** Improves control over output quality.

PROMPT CHAINING

- **Definition:** Splits a complex task into smaller subtasks, using outputs from one prompt as inputs for subsequent prompts.
- **Use Case:** Ideal for achieving consistency in complicated workflows.
- **Example:** Step 1: Generate an outline for an essay. Step 2: Expand each section into paragraphs.
- **Advantages:** Enhances reliability for multi-step processes.
